# Joseph's Workbench

If I told you there was something that could reduce illness, mental and physical, by 30%, would you take it? You might say it's too good to be true, or wonder what the catch is. Hold those questions, because they are good ones, first, let me reveal this miracle method: going to church!

A recent article summarized a new study confirming previous ones, that church attendance correlates with good health, the article states:

In previous studies, VanderWeele had discovered that weekly service attendance in adulthood was associated with "about 30 percent reductions in all-cause mortality, 30 percent reduction to the incidence of depression, [and] fivefold reductions in suicides."

Now this is an association or correlation, not necessarily a cause. For instance, regular exercise improves one's health, I'm not very regular in my exercise, so my improvement from church attendance may well be less than that of attendees who exercise. But this good outcome of church attendance is a long-standing finding of sociological surveys.

And the benefits of church attendance show up in studies of youth too:

Furthermore, "regular service attendance helps shield children from the 'big three' dangers of adolescence: depression, substance abuse, and premature sexual activity," VanderWeele writes in his latest article for Christianity Today. "People who attended church as children are also more likely to grow up happy, to be forgiving, to have a sense of mission and purpose, and to volunteer."

We are now entering Advent, a time of preparation for welcoming Jesus on Christmas. It is also an excellent time to invite friends and family to church to renew their faith. Don't be afraid to tell them "going to church is good for you!"

We need to remember that how things are now is not how they've always been; and it's not how they always will be.




We need to remember that your kingdom has come, that it is growing among us now, and that the time will come when it fills the world with justice and love.
